# Do You Need Help with School Clothes? Do You Need Help with School Supplies?

## **Clothes Connection & Supply Depot**

The Birdville ISD Council of PTAs operates two programs to help BISD students from low-income homes: *Clothes Connection & Supply Depot*. Students who qualify for **"Free and Reduced Lunch,"** as well as students who demonstrate a need, qualify for assistance. Families seeking assistance must qualify for the Free and Reduced Lunch Program or be referred by school personnel. The confirmation letter received from the BISD Child Nutrition office will be used to determine eligibility. Contact the Child Nutrition office for a copy of your confirmation letter.

*Clothes Connection & Supply Depot* services are available <u>only to BISD families</u> with an established need. If you have questions about whether your family qualifies, please ask the school contact person (usually a nurse or counselor). Please do not show up at *Clothes Connection & Supply Depot* without your confirmation letter or referral or you will not be able to obtain clothes.

# What is available for qualified families?

- one week's worth of new underwear, new socks, and gently used clothes, once per semester for each qualified student
- one shoe voucher to <u>Payless Shoesource</u>, once per school year for each qualified student
- jacket and coat, once per year for each qualified student

**Clothes Connection & Supply Depot** are volunteer run programs operating solely through financial and clothing donations from our community. Donations of gently used children's clothing are accepted at the **Clothes Connection** facility during regular business hours.



### **Clothing and Shoe Vouchers**

The *Clothes Connection* will be open to serve families <u>before school begins</u> in August. You must bring your confirmation letter from the Child Nutrition office in order to receive service. <u>Due to volunteer limitations, we only guarantee</u> <u>admission to the first 40 families in line each day.</u>

- Dates open:
  - $\circ~$  Saturday, August 18 from 8:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.
  - $\circ~$  Monday, August 20 from 8:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.
  - Tuesday, August 21 from 8:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.
  - Wednesday, August 22 from 8:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

Beginning September 4, 2012, the *Clothes Connection* will be open regular hours: Tuesdays and Wednesday from 9:00a.m. - 12:00p.m., except school holidays.

#### **School Supplies and Backpacks**

School supplies are delivered directly to each campus before school begins in August. Each campus determines how to distribute supplies to their students.

- Supplies are pre-packaged by school levels (K-2 elementary, 3-5 elementary, 6-8 middle, and high school.)
- 17" Backpacks

Due to the large number of students served, *Supply Depot* cannot provide school-specific supplies. Instead, grade leveled pre-packed basic supplies are distributed. Teachers and campuses are aware of this policy and are responsible for supply distribution to students. Contact your campus for more information.
