Important Testing Dates: STAAR/EOC State of Texas Assessment of Academic Readiness frequently called EOC meaning End of Course exams will be given to in English I, Algebra I, and Biology for 9th graders, and English 2 to 10th graders. Successful scores on these tests are

required for graduation. The testing window is March 28-31. The specific date will be determined by the district and campus, then announced. Please make note of these important dates.

PSAT, **October 19, 2016**. PSAT stands for the Pre-Scholastic Aptitude Test, the results assist students in anticipating their performance on the SAT college entrance test. It also determines the National Merit Scholarship finalists for 11th grade testers. Birdville ISD will purchase this test for all 10th graders for 2016-2017. All 10th graders have been provided with a test preparation booklet. Any 9th graders who want to test may register and pay for the test in the counseling office. The cost is \$15.00.
