## Description of Classes Offered

### CPR/AED Classes for Non-medical School Employees

#### Current Schedule of Classes

**January 4**  
**2 sessions (CPR/AED)**  
**8:00 PM – 11:30 PM and**  
**1:00 PM – 4:00 PM**

**April 11**  
**1 session (CPR/AED)**  
**8:00 PM – 11:30 PM**

- ▶ Adult and Child CPR - includes AED awareness and choking techniques.
  - Renewal required every two years
  - Required for all "front-line personnel", i.e., school secretaries, attendance clerks, receptionists; persons relieving in the nurses' offices; special ed teachers and EAs; coaches; health teachers; chief sponsors and coaches of extracurricular athletic-type events such as cheerleading, ROTC, marching band, drill team, & Special Olympics; nursing substitutes; bus drivers and attendants, etc.
  - Recommended for all lunch room monitors
  - Two summer classes are offered yearly; sign up required on ERO

**HeartSaver CPR in Schools** – includes instruction for students in CPR/AED and choking techniques

- ▶ Required for all ninth graders; appropriate for students grade 5 – grade 12
- ▶ Taught to ninth graders in health classes

### Healthcare Providers CPR

- ▶ BLS for HealthCare Providers – includes AED awareness, one and two-man CPR, choking techniques, mask usage, etc.
  - Renewal required every two years
  - Required for all nurses, athletic trainers, OT/PT consultants
  - Classes offered as needed

- ▶ BLS Instructor Course – includes instruction for teaching all CPR classes
  - Renewal required every two years
  - Required for all nurses
  - One class offered in the Spring
  - Sign up on ERO required
- ▶ HeartSaver Instructor Course – includes instruction for teaching all HeartSaver classes
  - Renewal required every two years
  - Required for all health teachers
  - Classes offered once a year
  - Sign up on ERO required
