Did you know ...

- BISD went from six exemplary campuses in 2008 to 11 in 2009.
- In fact, since 2005, the district has gone from one exemplary campus to 11.



Did you know ...

- Over the past 6 years, TAKS performance by African American, Hispanic and Economically Disadvantaged students increased by more than 28 percentage points in math, and increased by more than 40 percentage points in science. (2003 – 2009)
- Since 2003, commended performance on the state's TAKS test has increased by 25 percentage points in science, and by 32 percentage points in social studies. (2003 – 2009)

Did you know ...

- In 2009, BISD students took 2,433 AP exams, and scored a 3, 4 or 5 on 918 of the tests. This represents a potential savings in college tuition and fees of approximately \$800,000 for BISD parents. (918 tests x \$870 per 3 credit course = \$798,860)

Did you know ...

- In 2009, thirty-three BISD graduates were recognized by the National Merit program, which is three times the number recognized in the class of 2006.



Did you know ...

- Average ACT scores for BISD graduates over the past six years have met or exceeded the state and national average scores. (2004–2009)
- Average SAT scores for math and critical reading have consistently exceeded the state average over the past 10 years, and exceeded the national average in five of the past six years. (1998-2009)





Did you know ...

- Nineteen of our 21 elementary schools were rated as Recognized or Exemplary in 2009.



Did you know ...

- BISD received a rating of “Superior Achievement” under Texas’ Schools FIRST financial accountability rating system. The Superior Achievement rating is the state’s highest, demonstrating the quality of BISD’s financial management and reporting system.
