



## Destination Imagination 2019-2020

Do you have a K-12 child that enjoys working on a team, coming up with creative ideas, and finding solutions to problems? If so, Destination Imagination may be a great extra-curricular program for your child!

Destination Imagination teams are led by adult volunteers who are willing to manage a team of 7 students over the course of several months to solve a team challenge. After a team challenge is chosen, teams typically meet for an hour each week (either after school or on the weekends) with the schedule set by the team manager. Teams compete in a regional competition at the end of February, so team practice times may increase the closer it gets to regional competition time.
