What's Proposed in the 2018 School Bond Package?

Districtwide Safety/Security Upgrades

- Safety and Security Upgrades at All Facilities
 - Provides enhanced security at all campuses being rebuilt
 - Provides safety vestibules at:
 - North Oaks Middle School
 - North Ridge Middle School
 - Smithfield Middle School
 - Watauga Middle School
 - Academy at C.F. Thomas Elem.
 - Foster Village Elementary
 - Francisco Elementary
 - Green Valley Elementary
 - Hardeman Elementary

- Holiday Heights Elementary
- Mullendore Elementary
- North Ridge Elementary
- Porter Elementary
- Snow Heights Elementary
- Spicer Elementary



Districtwide Safety/Security Upgrades (2)



Safety and Security Upgrades at All Facilities

- Provides Intercom/Communication Systems to enhance safety on all campuses
- Addition of Lockdown buttons on all campuses



Districtwide Technology Upgrades

- Replacement of obsolete equipment
- Student/classroom technology upgrades
 - Moves from a 5:1 student-to-technology ratio to a 2:1 student-to-technology ratio
- Teacher/staff technology upgrades
- Network operations/disaster recovery servers and equipment updated
- Technology Bonds paid off in five years





Districtwide Repairs/Upgrades

- HVAC and roofing replacements
- Theater lighting upgrades at Birdville, Haltom and Richland high schools









New Construction

- Rebuild Haltom Middle School
 - Opened in 1956/Current Enrollment: 928
 - Eliminates 20 portable classrooms
 - Provides additional classroom and support space
 - Estimated <u>Cost to Repair Exceeds</u> 87% of Cost to Rebuild

Rebuild Richland Middle School

- Opened in 1956/Current Enrollment: 663
- Eliminates 18 portable classrooms
- Addresses structural/capacity issues
- Provides additional classroom and support space
- Estimated <u>Cost to Repair Exceeds</u> 83% of Cost to Rebuild



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New Construction (2)

- Rebuild Smithfield Elementary
 - Opened in 1954/Current Enrollment: 443
 - Eliminates four portable classrooms
 - Addresses structural and capacity issues
 - Provides additional classroom and support space
 - Estimated <u>Cost to Repair</u> <u>Exceeds</u> 75% of Cost to Rebuild





New Construction (3)

Build Partner Elementary School (Cheney/Richland)

Major Cheney Elementary at South Birdville

- Opened in 1953/Current Enrollment: 447
- Eliminates eight portable classrooms
- Estimated <u>Cost to Repair Exceeds</u> 74% of Cost to Rebuild

Richland Elementary

- Opened in 1953/Current Enrollment: 297
- BISD's smallest elementary school
- Estimated <u>Cost to Repair Exceeds</u> 59% of Cost to Rebuild


