Birdville ISD's bond referendum will not increase the property tax rate for homeowners or businesses.

However, a new state law requires all school bond referendum propositions to include ballot language that reads "THIS IS A PROPERTY TAX INCREASE." Passage of the bond package will not result in an increase in the property tax rate, despite the ballot language stating that there will be a tax increase.

The issuance of \$284,714,315 of bonds by the Birdville Independent School District for the purpose of constructing, renovating, improving and equipping school facilities in the District, including the acquisition of land therefor and the acquisition of new school buses and levying the tax in payment thereof. THIS IS A PROPERTY TAX INCREASE.

The issuance of \$16,061,775 of bonds by the Birdville Independent School District for the purpose of acquiring and updating instructional technology equipment and levying the tax in payment thereof. THIS IS A PROPERTY TAX INCREASE.

#### Birdville Independent School District Proposition C

Proposición C Del Distrito Escolar Independiente De Birdville

The issuance of \$59,000,000 of bonds by the Birdville Independent School District for the purpose of constructing, improving and equipping multi-purpose indoor facilities at each high school and levying the tax in payment thereof. THIS IS A PROPERTY TAX INCREASE.

State law is specific on the wording school districts are allowed to use when placing a bond election on the ballot. However, a new state law requires all school bond referendum propositions to include ballot language that reads "THIS IS A PROPERTY TAX INCREASE."

Passage of the bond package will not result in an increase in the property tax rate in Birdville ISD despite the mandated ballot language.

The District is presenting this as a package and asks voters to cast a vote on each of the three propositions.
