 - Maintain a bond repayment period of 25 years or less
 - Fully repay bonds issued for certain short-term projects over their useful lives
 - Technology devices 5 years
 - Buses 10 years
 - Technology infrastructure 10 years
 - Furniture, Fixtures and Equipment 10 years


