A. STADIUM

1. Home team will occupy north side of stadium and use west dressing room.
Band/Drill Team will be in a section designated by school.
2. Visiting team will occupy south side of stadium and use east dressing room.
Band/Drill Team will be in a section designated by school.
3. The Fine Arts/Athletics Complex provides standard maintenance, cleaning, and sanitized before arrival.

B. PARKING

1. All parking lots and bus lots will be utilized.
2. Team buses will unload at home or visitors dressing rooms on north side of stadium, then proceed around north side of stadium to bus parking on the west end.
3. Bus parking at west end of stadium will be used for pass gate for bands, drill teams, pep squads, etc. Buses enter on street at north side of stadium.
4. Parking will open 2 hours before game time for general public.
5. Stadium gates will open 1 1/2 hour before start of game.

C. COVID-19 RISK MITIGATION ATHLETIC GUIDELINES

In accordance with the University Interscholastic League (UIL) and Texas Governor Greg Abbott's Executive Order GA-29, face coverings will be mandatory for all UIL events at Silsbee ISD. This Executive Order became effective July 3, 2020. As the public health situation changes, and/or if subsequent Executive Orders are issued by Governor Greg Abbott, these guidelines may be further modified.

1. Face coverings include non-medical grade disposable face masks, cloth face coverings (over the nose and mouth), or full-face shields to protect eyes, nose, and mouth.
2. *All employees, parents, visitors and students ten years of age or older must wear face coverings or face shields upon entry to an area where UIL activities are being conducted and when not actively practicing or playing in the contest, unless an exception listed below applies.*

Exceptions to the wearing of face coverings or face shields include:

- Any person with a medical condition or disability that prevents wearing a face covering;
- While a person is consuming food or drink;
- When a congregating group of persons maintains at least 6 feet of social distancing; or
- Any other reason or circumstance indicated under [Executive Order GA-29](#).

Spectators, Audiences, Fans and Media

- Spectators that will attend games, contests, or events will be limited to within a maximum 50% capacity, provided that appropriate spacing between spectators is maintained according to the protocol.
- Spectators, audiences, fans and media are required to wear face coverings as described in Executive Order GA-29.
