


Dual Credit-RichlandHigh School February 2, 2021

FERPA (Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act)

- It is a violation of federal law to release student educational information without student consent.
- Dual credit students sign a release allowing their information to be shared with parents.
- Although parents share ownership of the K-12 student record with their child, once the student enrolls in higher education the FERPA rights transfer solely to the student.

Score Release Form

Students attending TWU who tested at an alternate institution should complete the Score Release Form to allow retrieval and posting of TSIA scores to their student account.

Score Release Form

Academic Testing Services provides an official copy of TSIA scores to students upon completion of test session.

TWU does not email or mail score reports to other Texas public institutions. Students should contact the institution they plan to attend for score retrieval.

Application Process for Dual Credit

- Complete the ApplyTexas Freshman application, found at <u>ApplyTexas</u>.
- **2. A \$50 non-refundable application fee** (can be done online with ApplyTexas application or mail to TWU, Office of Admissions Processing, PO Box 425649, Denton, TX 76204-5589).
- **3. Submit official <u>TSI scores</u> OR the <u>Score Release Form</u> (pdf) to the Office of Admissions Processing to give TWU permission to retrieve official TSI scores from other in-state colleges and universities.**
- 4. Students must return the completed <u>Dual Credit Permission Form 2020-2021</u> to a high school counselor.
- 5. Submit a recent official high school transcript. Reminder: Submit all official college transcripts anywhere you have attempted or earned college credit.

- Apply Texas is the application used for Dual Credit and there is a one-time \$50 application fee.
- Fee can only be paid online at the time of submission.
- Follow the step by step application instructions.


Creating a Pioneer Portal Account

Creating a Pioneer Portal Account

New Dual Credit Students

If you are a new dual credit student and need to create your Pioneer Portal account:

- · Go to the Create a Pioneer Portal website
- Fill out the form with the following required information:
- o Last name
- o Social security number (or TWU student ID number)
- o Birth date
- · Create a password
- The password must be complex and follow the instructions on the screen
- · Click "Create My Account"
- Please write-down or make note of your username that
 is presented on the results screen; this will be your email address and username to access all
 TWU systems.
- Once an account has been created, please wait about ten minutes for all account access to be created and pushed through our systems. The TWU Gmail account itself will be completed within 1–2 hours with no further action.

- Visit <u>WebAdvisor</u> and "Log In" via the link in the upper right corner (or access it via the link on your <u>Pioneer Portal</u> homepage)
- 2. Select the "Applicants" blue rectangle
- 3. Review your applicant and account information
- 4. Check for missing documents:
- o Select "My Documents" under the Communication heading
- 5. Check application status:
- o Select "Admission Status" under the Admission Information heading

Additionally, monitoring your TWU email account will help you stay informed.


