- Current Driver's License
- BHS Parking Packet completed with all signatures and fees
- Senior Painted Parking Spot sketch, fees, registration form signed by parent and student regardless of age

Sale:

- Seniors only Tuesday, 08/01/2023 8:00AM 11:00AM
- All Parking Wednesday, 08/02/2023 8:00AM 11:00AM
- All Parking Tuesday, 08/22/2023 3:00PM 4:00PM
- Students will line up in Café
- First come, first served
- Students will select their parking spot in sequence, and will have row preference.
- After the above dates, parking will be sold throughout the school year in the student services office

Guidelines:

- Students must paint the entire space with a designated gray paint before painting their approved design. (see paint requirement below)
- Students are not to paint their spots without BHS administration approval.
- Students are allowed to paint the entire parking spot they have purchased.

- Students will **not** be allowed to paint over or amend the parking spot number or paint outside of the designated space.
- Students will be asked to paint over the spot at the end of the year with the designated gray paint.

Paint:

- Students must provide their own paint. (exterior latex paint only)
- Designated District Gray- Glidden, Gray Frost PPG1012-4 or Behr, Rainmaster MQ5-22

Cost:

- \$50.00 Senior painted space, rows 1-14 * Painted spots are based on availability.
- \$30.00-all other parking spaces
- Cash /Check made payable to BHS (include DL# of person signing check)
- Parking Fees are not refundable.
- If you lose your tag you will be subject to a replacement fee.

To ensure the safety of our students, it is required that students comply with all parking and driving regulations set forth by BHS and the North Richland Hills Police Department. Failure to abide by these rules may result in temporary or permanent loss of parking privileges.

Closed Campus:

All high schools in BISD are considered "closed" during the day, meaning that students are not allowed to leave for any reason without permission from their assistant principal.

Students driving to attend class at another school, or students who have early release will be required to present their ID / PASS to the security guard as they leave the parking lot.

Students needing to go to their vehicle during the school day must notify an assistant principal prior to leaving the building. Students are not allowed to sit in their vehicles during the school day.

Parking Option: STUDENTS MAY ONLY PARK IN THEIR DESIGNATED

SPOT IN THE STUDENT LOT

Parking Violations: Illegal or Inappropriate Parking

Students are not allowed anywhere but their designated spot:

Parking spots in front and back of BHS and teacher lots are offlimits.

Handicap Spots-Must have valid pass in student name and cleared through BHS parking office.

Unauthorized Use or Forgery of Documents and/or Parking Pass may result in immediate and permanent parking suspension and disciplinary action

Other Violations:

Any offense may result in parking privileges being revoked, including:

Speeding/Reckless Driving

Failure to Follow Instructions / Directions from Security Guard Truancy/Leaving Campus in Vehicle without Permission

Search and Seizure:

The district shall use specially trained dogs to sniff out and alert officials of the current presence of concealed prohibited items. Trained dogs may sniff lockers, vehicles, classrooms and other common areas at any time. If contraband of any kind is found, the possessing student shall be subject to appropriate disciplinary action in accordance with the Student Code of Conduct Booklet. (STUDENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE for all items in their vehicle.)

Refusal of search or entry into vehicle could result in DAEP placement.

Suspended/Expelled/DAEP Students who are suspended, expelled or assigned to DAEP will not be allowed to return to campus for any reason until the suspension is completed. Students suspended, expelled or assigned to DAEP driving on the BHS campus may risk permanently losing their parking privileges and face disciplinary action.

Parking privileges can be revoked at any time if deemed necessary and reasonable by school administration

VEHICLE SAFETY

Students are encouraged to keep vehicles locked and store any personal items in the trunk. BHS or BISD is NOT responsible for any vehicle damage or theft. BHS Security monitors the student lot often. Park in your designated spot only so your vehicle is easy to identify.
