

Basketball Game Spectators COVID 19 Protocol

In order to continue to adhere to the COVID 19 Safety Plan, we will follow the protocols listed below

- Each Basketball player will be permitted 2 adult spectators and siblings that live in the players household to watch the game in the gym.
- Visiting coaches will provide the host school with a roster of A team and B team players prior to arrival for gate keeping attendance purposes. This allows us to adhere to the 2 adults per player policy.
- Household groups must sit together, and social distancing guidelines will be enforced by staff.
- At 4:45 pm, we will open the outside doors and admit spectators for the 5:00pm "B" Basketball game
- Upon conclusion of the "B" Game, we will clear the gym of spectators and players/coaches. Spectators will exit through the Southwest outside exit door inside the Main Gym.
- There will be a 10-15 min sanitization period between games for the facility.
- Staff will open the Gym entrance for "A" team spectators upon the completion of between game sanitation.
- "A" team spectators will enter the gym and adhere to the same protocols as "B" team spectators.
- Upon ending of the "A" game, spectators will exit through the Southwest outside exit doors located inside the Main Gym.

We realize these protocols can be inconvenient and may not be agreed upon by everyone in attendance. Please know that we will be enforcing them completely and consistently. Everything we are doing is to keep our students, families, and staff safe. Our goal is for your kids to be able to have a basketball season that we believe they desperately want and need. We ask that you comply agreeably with these measures and avoid anyone having to be put in a difficult situation.
