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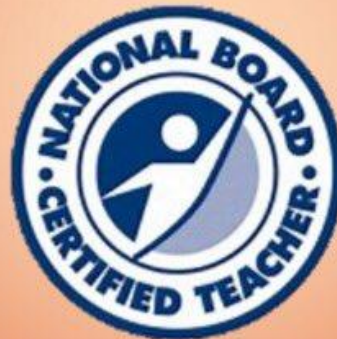

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Four Components of Certification

1

- **Content Knowledge**
- Computer-Based Assessment
- Content Knowledge and Pedagogy

- **Differentiation in Instruction**
- Analyze student strengths and needs
- Student work samples and written commentary

3

- **Teaching Practice and Learning Environment**
- Video recording of teaching and learning
- Written commentary

4

- **Effective and Reflective Practitioner**
- Assessment, Planning, Collaboration - to Advance Student Learning



Cohorts and Support

- ❑ Coaching and feedback along the way
- ❑ Access to teachers that are National Board Certified
- ❑ Access to content and pedagogy experts to support
- ❑ Scheduled but voluntary meetings to support teachers
- ❑ Reimbursement for teachers that earn their National Board Certification



Financial Support

- ❑ Districts and TEA will support teachers financially
- ❑ Each component costs \$495.00
- ❑ Districts can request reimbursement from TEA on behalf of the teacher.
- ❑ Once a teacher passes all components of the National Board Certification, the district will reimburse the teacher for the \$1900.00 fees.
- ❑ Teachers will pay the \$75.00 registration fee
