Ticket Distribution / Parking

Parking

The District has arranged for **FREE PARKING** in Lot R for all BISD graduates and their guests.

Globe Life Field COVID-19 Requirements for Guests

- Globe Life Field requires all guests ages two and older to wear a mask. Masks are not required while eating or drinking.
- A ticket/seat is required for all guests 36" or taller. Those shorter than 36" may sit in the lap of a ticketed guest.
- **Bag Policy**
 - Only the following bags are permitted in Globe Life Field for the in-person graduation event:
 - Bags carried for medical reasons; and
 - Manufactured diaper bags that accompany infants and young children.
 - **All other bags, including camera bags, are prohibited.**

Graduation Tickets

In order to maintain social distancing, each graduate will have an assigned seat in Sections 1–25 based on their last name. (There will be designated seating for handicapped students.)

Exception: Sections 13–14 (behind home plate) will be reserved for the families of the Top 12 students (five seats per graduate). Beyond the reserved sections, all other assigned seating will be randomly selected.

Family/Guest Tickets

Based on social distancing guidelines, each graduate's family will be allotted five seats. The seats will be randomly selected and assigned. (Families must sit in their assigned seats.) You must have your ticket to be admitted into Globe Life Field.

BISD's administration has worked hard to help families that need more than five seats. Families needing up to five (5) additional seats* (non-premium seats only) must complete the **Additional Ticket Request Form** online at [\[INSERT APPROPRIATE UPDATED LINK\]](#) and submit their request. The Additional Ticket Request Form **opens Monday, May 10** and **closes Monday, May 17**. (Only one request per student/family will be accepted.)

** The additional randomly-selected non-premium seats must be given out in groups of five. BISD cannot break those groupings.*

These additional seats will **not** be with the original seats provided to each graduate's family. However, they will be assigned in other sections on the same level. Again, based on the state's social distancing requirements, the District is not able to group all 10 seats together.

Seniors may pick up tickets at the school on Friday, May 21. If they are unable to pick up tickets on that day, please contact the school office.

Attention Families That May Need More Than 10 Tickets!

On the bottom of the **Additional Ticket Request Form**, there is a check box for families to request tickets beyond the five (5) non-premium tickets for a total of 15 tickets. If they are available, tickets will be in groups of five (5) and will not be with the other tickets provided. Don't forget to check the box on the request form. Tickets will be available on a first-come-first-served basis.

BISD Will Stream Graduation Ceremonies LIVE

Do you have family and friends who are not able to attend graduation this year? BISD has been working with Globe Life Field to be able to livestream each of the graduation ceremonies using Facebook Live. Don't have Facebook? That's okay. Go to birdvilleschools.net to view the live event on the front of the District's website.

Arrival Time

Graduates are expected to arrive 60 minutes before their ceremony begins, exit their car to put on their graduation cap/gown at their parking space, and then walk to the **VIP Entry**, maintaining appropriate distance from other graduates. Once the graduate arrives, high school staff will check them in and guide the graduate to their personalized seating area where they are to remain prior to the ceremony. **NOTE:** Graduates **MUST** have their ticket to enter.

Guests may begin arriving 60 minutes before the ceremony begins and are asked to follow the guidance of event staff to enter at the **Toyota Southwest Entry** (see attachment). Guests must have their ticket to enter.

Seating

Guests will have assigned seats and can only sit in their assigned seats.

Globe Life Field Concessions

Limited Concession Stands will be open.

Sanitizing and Cleaning

Event staff from Globe Life Field will follow CDC cleaning guidelines before, during, and after each ceremony.

After the Ceremony

Graduates and guests will be asked to remain in their seats until their section is released by the appropriate staff. Once released, they should exit the stadium and go straight to their personal vehicles.

Families of graduates will not be allowed on the field before, during, or after the ceremony.

All guests will exit the stadium as guided by event staff and go directly to their vehicles in Lot R (see attachment).

Security staff will help direct traffic out of the stadium.

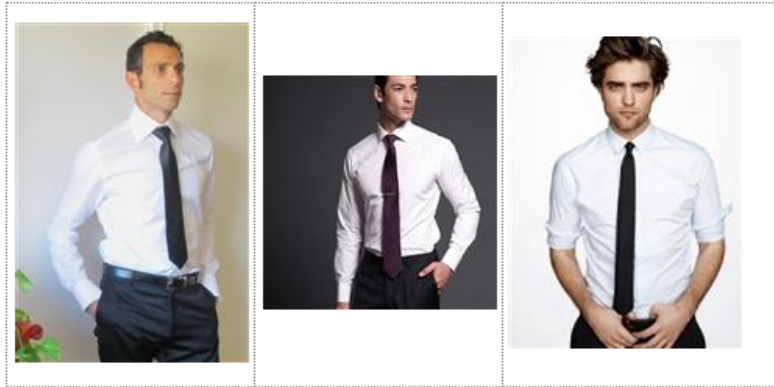
Graduation Dress Attire
