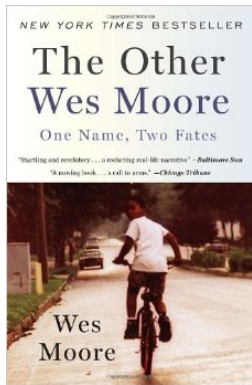


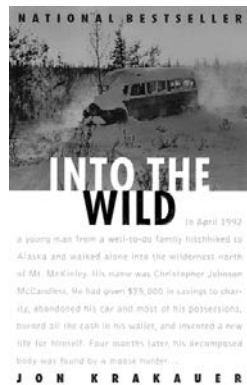
Summer Reading 2016

AP Language and Composition

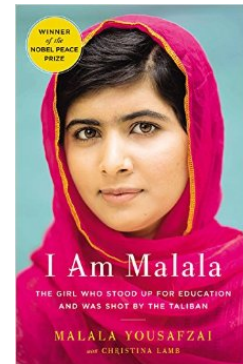
