

ORDER DECLARING RESULTS OF ELECTION

On this the 17th day of May, 2022, the Board of Trustees of the BIRDEVILLE INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT convened in special session with the following members, to-wit:

thus, constituting a quorum (per Election Code 67.004(a) two members constitute a quorum for purposes of canvassing an election.), and among other proceedings had by said Board of Trustees were the following:

There came on to be heard the returns of the trustee election held on the 7st day of May 2022, for the purpose of electing two members to the Board of Trustees, one for Place 6 and one for Place 7; and said returns of the trustee election having been duly canvassed by the Board of Trustees and there being cast at said election the following votes:

For Place 6, a total of 5,840 votes, with each of the candidates for said Place 6 receiving the following votes, to-wit:

For Place 7, a total of 6,183 votes, with each of the candidates for said Place 7 receiving the following votes, to-wit:

And it appearing to the Board of Trustees and the said Board so finding:

That Ralph Kunkel received the highest number of votes cast for Place 6 and Kris Drees received the highest number of votes cast for Place 7.

IT IS, THEREFORE, FOUND AND DECLARED AND SO ORDERED by the Board of Trustees of the BIRDVILLE INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT that the above Trustee Election was duly called, that notice of said election was duly posted and that said election was held in accordance with law; and that at said election **Ralph Kunkel and Kris Drees**, were elected to said Board of Trustees subject to taking the oath of office.

It is further found and determined that written notice of the date, place and subject of this meeting was posted in the front window of the Administration Building used for posting notices of the meetings of the Board of Trustees, in a place convenient and readily accessible to the general public, and said notice, having been so posted, remained posted for the time required by law to precede the scheduled time of said meeting.

The above Order being read, it was moved and seconded that same do pass. Thereupon, the question being called for, with all members of said Board shown present above voting "AYE," except as noted below.
