ORDER CANVASSING ELECTION RETURNS

WHEREAS, this Board of Trustees (the "Board") ordered an election (the "Election") to be held in the Birdville Independent School District (the "District") on November 8, 2022, on the propositions hereinafter stated, and has authorized all matters pertaining to the Election, including the ordering, giving notice, officers, holding and making returns of the Election; and

WHEREAS, the election officers who held the Election have duly made the returns of the result thereof, and said returns have been duly delivered to the Board; and

WHEREAS, it is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Order was adopted was open to the public, and public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given, all as required by Chapter 551, Texas Government Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF BIRDVILLE INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT:

1. The Board officially finds and determines that the Election was duly ordered, that proper notice of the Election was duly given, that proper election officers were duly appointed prior to the Election, that the Election was duly held, that the District has complied with the Federal Voting Rights Act and the Texas Election Code, that due returns of the result of the Election have been made and delivered, and that the Board has duly canvassed said returns, all in accordance with law and the Order calling the Election.

2. The Board officially finds and determines that the following votes were cast at the Election, on the submitted PROPOSITIONS by the resident, qualified electors of the District, who voted at the Election:

Shall the Board of Trustees of the Birdville Independent School District be authorized to issue bonds of the District, in one or more series, in the aggregate principal amount of \$284,714,315 for the purpose of constructing, renovating, improving and equipping school facilities in the District, including the acquisition of land therefor and the acquisition of new school buses, with the bonds to mature, bear interest and be issued and sold in accordance with law at the time of issuance; and shall the Board of Trustees be authorized to levy and pledge, and cause to be assessed and collected, annual ad valorem taxes, on all taxable property in the District, sufficient, without limit as to rate or amount, to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds and the cost of any credit agreements executed in connection with the bonds?
