Supplies to be kept by student ALL year- students should have them at all times.
(Note: These supplies will need to be replenished and replaced as needed)

- Zipper Style Binder
- zipper pencil pouch with 3 holes
- notebook paper (purchase several packages & leave at home for replenishment)
- handheld pencil sharpener with cover
- ear buds (to be kept in backpack for school use)
- # 2 pencils, with erasers (they go through A LOT of these)
- 1 pkg colored pencils
- 1 package non-toxic markers

The following supplies will be needed for specific content areas.

ELA/Reading

- (2) 100 page composition books wide rule
- yellow pocket folder with side pockets and brads (for Reading)

Math

- red pocket folder with side pockets and brads
- (1) 100 page composition books

Science

- (1) 100 page composition book (not spiral)
- blue pocket folder with side pockets and brads

Social Studies

- spiral notebook
- green pocket folder with side pockets and brads

Supplies that will be collected for student use in all core academic classes

- 2 boxes of tissue

Supplies to be used in all of their classes

- 1 pkg notebook paper, wide rule
- 4 Highlighters (1 each of 4 different colors)
