

Senior Checklist for TCC

APPLY

- Complete and submit an application for admission at www.applytexas.org.
 - Be sure to list your high school.
 - Be sure to include your full social security number. Only undocumented students are not required to provide a complete social security number.
 - If you previously submitted your application without a social security number, please bring your social security card and photo ID to the Admissions and Registrar's office.
- Check your email for your myTCC email address, Student ID, and WebAdvisor login.
- Check your myTCC email account often (my.tccd.edu).

FINANCIAL AID (FAFSA OR TASFA)

- FAFSA (or TASFA) application must be completed and received by TCC by July 1st for the fall or December 1st for the spring.
- Fill out your FAFSA at www.fafsa.ed.gov or complete a paper TASFA at the Student Financial Aid Services office on campus.
 - TCC School Code: 003626.
 - The FAFSA application opens October 1st of your senior year.
- In May (for the fall) or October (for the spring), log in to your WebAdvisor account (wa.tccd.edu) and check to see that your FAFSA/TASFA application was received by TCC
 - Look under Financial Aid Services and choose the first link "Self-Service Financial Aid" – the login will match your WebAdvisor login.
- **If you are not able to confirm this information contact the TCC Foundation at 817-515-5277 before June 1st (for the fall) or November 1st (for the spring).** This will give you time to take any corrective action, provide missing information or to complete the verification process required for your FAFSA/TASFA application to be considered complete by the deadline.
- ***Helpful hint** – check your myTCC student email often for updates on this process.

SUBMIT REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- Deliver your official High School transcript to Admissions and Registrar's Office by July 1st (for the fall) or December 1st (for the spring).

DUAL CREDIT STUDENTS

- Dual credit students are not eligible for the BISD scholarship.
- After high school transcript has been submitted and a valid undergraduate program has been added, student will need to notify Student Financial Aid Services that they are no longer a dual credit student.

DATE OF BIRTH OF AUGUST 30, 2001 OR PRIOR

- Any student with a date of birth of August 30, 2001 or earlier will need to contact the TCC Foundation Office at 817-515-5277...

FAMILY EDUCATIONAL RIGHTS AND PRIVACY ACT (FERPA) WAIVER OF PRIVACY

- Students must fill out the FERPA Waiver of Privacy Form in order to give permission for TCC to speak to parents.

- Students starting in the fall:

October 1st	FAFSA application opens
May 1st	Confirm TCC has FAFSA
June 1st	Contact TCC Foundation if FAFSA not received
July 1st	Deadline to complete admission process including FAFSA and submission of high school transcript

- Students starting in the spring:

October 1st	FAFSA application opens
October 1st	Confirm TCC has FAFSA
November 1st	Contact TCC Foundation if FAFSA not received
December 1st	Deadline to complete admission process including FAFSA and submission of high school transcript
