Parents and students are encouraged to use Skyward access to stay current with grades and attendance. Parents can continue to use logins and passwords from previous years. New parents can get their logins/passwords from the front office with ID. This login will be used for Skyward, computer and Chromebook access, and most other applications within BISD. **Username**: First Letter of the Student's First Name + First Letter of their Middle Name + First 5 Letters of their Last Name + a 3 digit number. (ex Jane Doe Hawks would be JDHawks000)

Password: Students will continue to use their password from the previous year. If they need to reset their password, you can email helpdesk@birdvilleschools.net (you will need your Student ID number) or a staff member can call the help desk at 5888 with the student's ID number ready.

Students who are new to BISD may have a staff member look up their login and password.

Please be advised that excessive absences (more than 8 per semester) can lead to non-crediting a class and can impact semester exam exemptions and the ability to obtain VOE forms.

Students who are sick for a couple of days should check for missed assignments on each teacher's Canvas page.

<u>Important Testing Dates</u>: **STAAR/EOC** State of Texas Assessment of Academic Readiness frequently called EOC meaning End of Course exams will be given in English I, Algebra I, and Biology for 9th graders, and English 2 to 10th graders. Successful scores on these tests are required for graduation. The testing window is April 5 – May 4, 2022. Please make note of these important dates. The December retesting window is December 7-9, 2021.
