<u>Important Testing Dates</u>: **STAAR/EOC** State of Texas Assessment of Academic Readiness frequently called EOC (End of Course) exams will be given in English I, Algebra I, and Biology for 9th graders, and English 2 to 10th graders. Successful scores on these tests are required for graduation.

<u>DUAL CREDIT COURSES</u>: Dual credit courses are offered at the junior level. Sophomores, if you are interested in taking a dual credit course next year, a parent meeting will be held in January 2024. This meeting is for parents and students new to the dual credit program.

PSAT, October 11, 2023: PSAT stands for the Pre-Scholastic Aptitude Test, the results assist students in anticipating their performance on the SAT college entrance test. It also determines the National Merit Scholarship finalists for 11th grade testers. Birdville ISD will purchase this test for all 10th graders for 2023. All 10th graders will automatically be registered and will be provided a test preparation booklet.
