The Battle of the Books is a district-wide competition in Birdville ISD. The district's next competitions will be for the 2021-2022 school year. The list will remain the same as the 2020-21 list, since the competition for this year has been cancelled.

The primary goal of the program is to promote close reading in a wide variety of genres, diverse literature, and multiple narrative styles that introduce students to numerous authors.

The Battle of the Books program strives to foster academic competition, encourage students to collaborate as a team, enhance reading comprehension levels and critical thinking, and create a statewide recognized list of exemplary titles for elementary students.

The program is voluntary. Those students wishing to participate are asked to read the books selected for their respective grade levels and qualify for their individual campus teams. District-wide competition is held every January.
