PROGRAM CONTINGENCY UPDATE

- North Richland Middle School
 - Market escalation was sudden and dramatic
 - Low bid was 25% over budget

Budget: \$30,650,000
 Low Bid: \$36,788,598
 Overage: \$(6,128,598)

- Design was tight; meets District's needs
 - Square footage was on target; no extravagances
 - Budget estimates during design were on target
- Major value engineering was not recommended
 - Cuts would be too painful to tolerate
 - Minor value engineering during bid negotiations yielded \$(598,765) in reductions



PROGRAM CONTINGENCY UPDATE (continued)

- North Richland Middle School
 - The Board was presented was presented with two options
 - OPTION 1
 - Approve the use of program contingency funds
 - \$10.13 million
 Program Contingency Balance (\$6.69 million for Construction / \$3.44 million for Technology)
 - \$\(\frac{\\$(6.12 \text{ million})}{\}\) North Richland Middle School Budget Overage
 - \$4.01 million
 Projected Program Contingency Balance*
 - *Project savings will accumulate throughout the Bond Program to replenish contingency.
 - *Child Nutrition funds may be available to offset some of the budget overage for this school
 - Consideration: Bidding is complete for all major projects except Birdville Elementary
 - If project bids over \$200 per foot (not predicted), there would remain sufficient contingency to cover the overage
 - OPTION 2
 - Postpone the project for one year; wait to see if market conditions improve (not expected; could worsen)
 - The Board chose Option 1 and approved the use of Program Contingency at the December 2015 meeting

- Network Infrastructure Upgrades
 - All remaining cable upgrade projects approved by Board at December 2015 meeting
 - Expected Board approval for the network equipment: February 2016
 - Completion: Varies by location, but E-Rate requires total completion by August 31, 2017
- Network Operations Center: Fiber expansion and Tape Drive Replacement
 - Expected Board approval: February 2016
 - Completion: April 2016
- Technology Devices for Wave 2 Campuses
 - Expected Board approval: March 2016
 - Completion: Summer 2016

- Safety and Security
 - Over 400 out dated cameras have been replaced at almost all locations throughout the district.
 - Another 350 cameras will be installed in Wave 1 and Wave 2 campuses this summer.







PROJECTS IN PROGRESS (Continued)

- Surface Pro Mobile Devices for Principals, Assistant Principals, and Central Admin.
 - Wave 1, Wave 2, and a large portion of central administration has been completed
 - Expanding deployment to Wave 3 and wave 4 principals and Aps
 - Completion: April 2016

- Project Innovate iPads
 - Recipients are required to sign up for and attend a 1 hour Project Innovate training session conducted by Digital Learning Team
 - These trainings are popular and fill up quickly, typically within minutes of becoming available.
