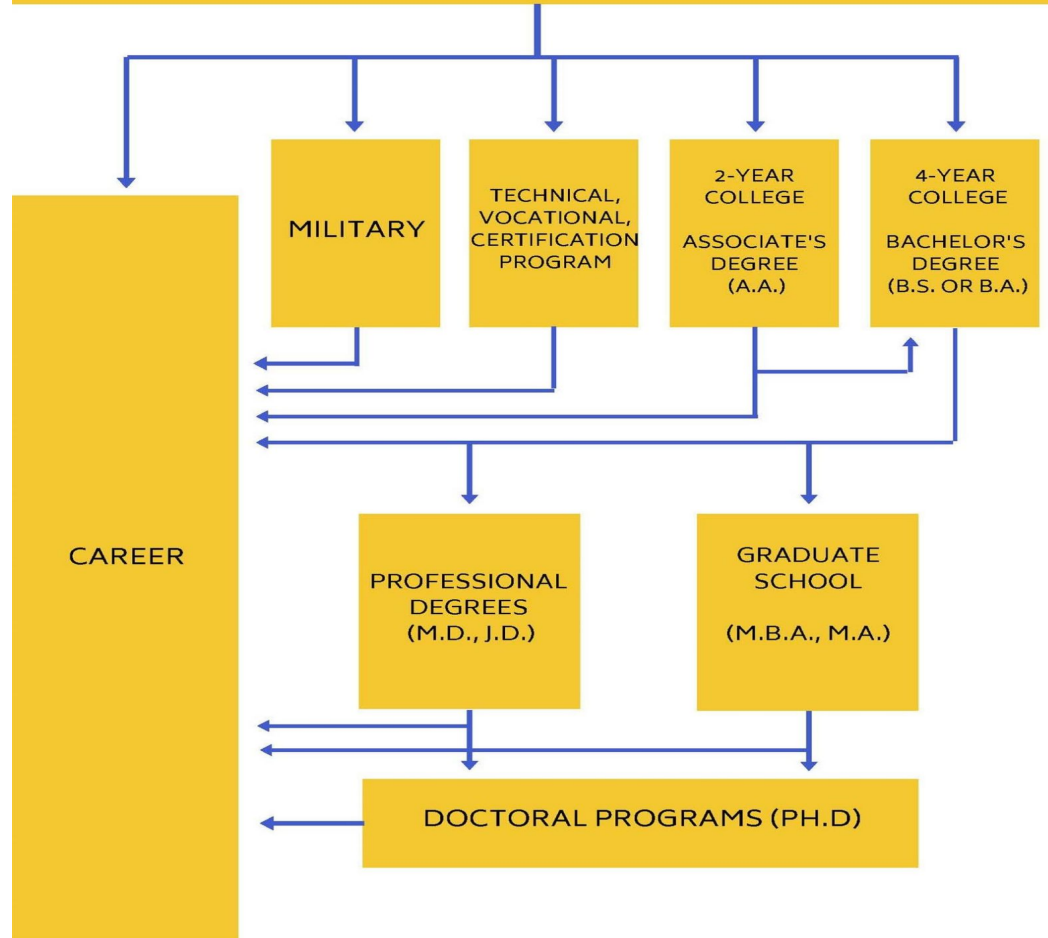

2. Submit a completed financial aid application

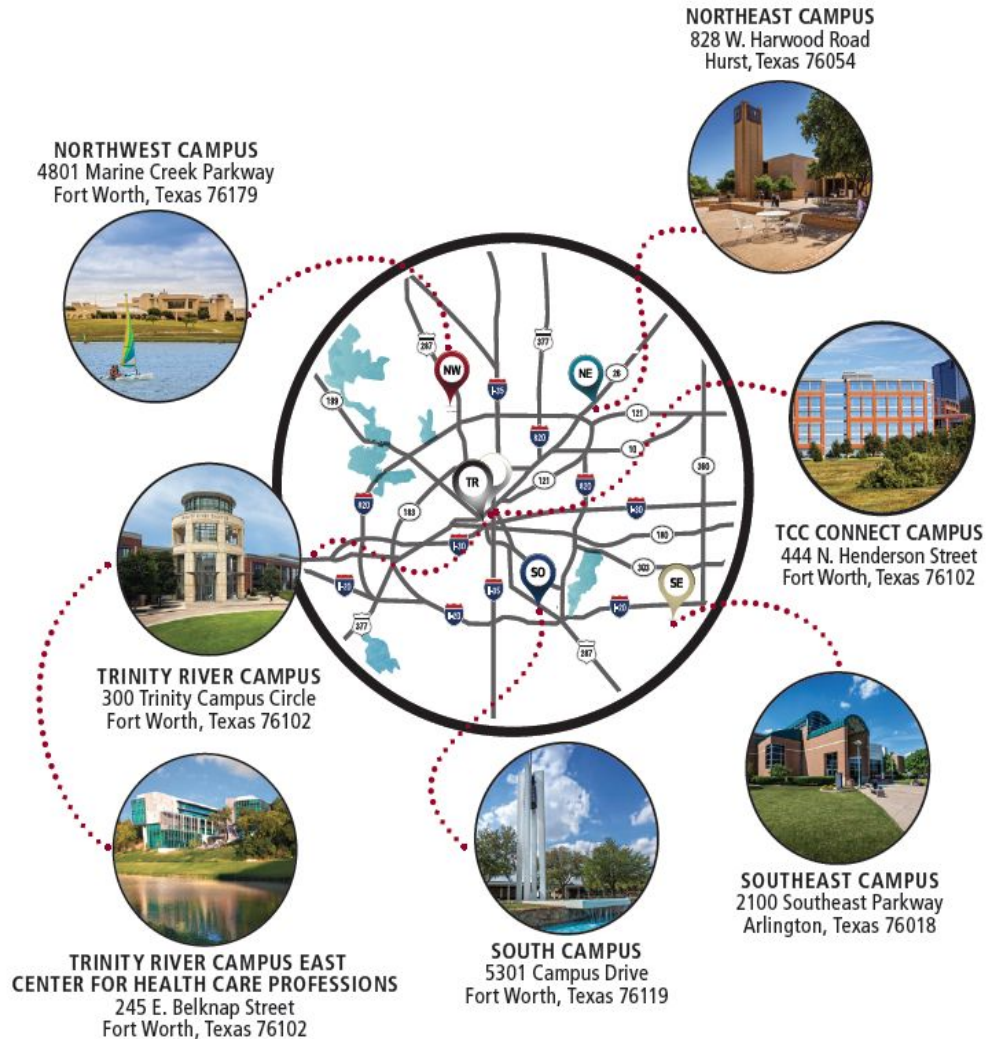



THE BIRDVILLE ISD SCHOLARSHIP

pays tuition costs for up to 15 credit hours at in-county tuition rates for qualified students who have graduated from a Birdville ISD high school.

Birdville ISD Scholarship Criteria

This scholarship is available for two consecutive semesters, not including summer. It must be first awarded within one year of high school graduation.

Applicants must complete the entire admissions process for TCC.

- Submit a complete admissions application with accurate information
- Send the official high school transcript(s) to the Admissions and Registrar Office on your campus
- Complete testing requirements
- Complete all new to college requirements

Complete the FAFSA or TASFA application for a determination of financial need. The school code for TCC is 003626. The entire process must be completed and results received by TCC before the semester deadline.

FAFSA VS TASFA

FAFSA

- Free Application for Federal Student Aid
- Opens **October 1st**
- Students who can apply:
 - US Citizens
 - Permanent U.S. resident with Alien Registration Card (I-551)
 - Conditional Permanent U.S. Resident with visa type I-551C
 - Classified as refugee

TASFA

- Texas Application for State Financial Aid
- Opens **October 1st**
- Students who should fill out the TASFA:
 - Undocumented students
 - DACA (Deferred Action Childhood Arrival)

Documents Needed for FAFSA Completion...

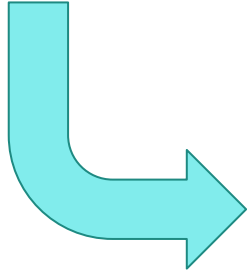

- Record of savings and checking accounts



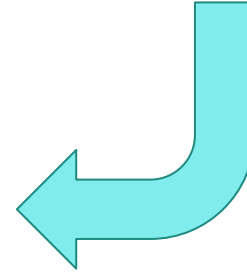
