Cost:	Free for the 2023-2024 School Year!
Required Documents:	The following documents are required prior to issuing a parking permit: Current U.S. driver's license (expired license will not be accepted) Signed parking contract by student, and parent or guardian (regardless of age) *also be prepared to give your license plate #, make/model, color of vehicle AND cell phone #*
Vehicle Safety:	Students are encouraged to lock their cars and store personal items in the trunk. Students should not loan their car keys to anyone, and report stolen or lost keys to Mr. Williams, Principal as soon as possible. Vehicles deemed unsafe will not be allowed parking privileges. BISD or BCTAL is not responsible for vehicle damage or theft.
Closed Campus:	All high schools in BISD are considered "closed" during the day, meaning that students are not allowed to leave for any reason without permission from their teacher and/or principal. Students needing to leave/ re-enter the student parking lot during the school day need to notify their teacher and/or principal prior to leaving the building. Students are not allowed to sit in their vehicles during the school day. Students who have early release will be required to sign out in the Forum area. ALWAYS have a BCTAL badge in plain sight.
Extra-Curricular Events:	All parking rules apply during any extra-curricular event.
Search and Seizure:	By law, each vehicle parked in any parking lot on campus is subject to search if the school administrative staff has a reasonable suspicion that a search is deemed necessary for the safety and security of the students.
DAEP Students:	Students assigned to the DAEP will not be allowed to return to campus for any reason until the DAEP assignment is completed. DAEP students driving on the BCTAL campus may risk permanently losing their parking privileges and face disciplinary action.
Suspended/Expelled Students:	Students who are suspended or expelled will not be allowed to return to campus for any reason until the suspension is completed. Suspended or expelled students driving on the BCTAL campus may risk permanently losing their parking privileges and face disciplinary action.
Parking Violations:	To ensure the safety of our students, it is required that students comply with all parking and driving regulations set forth by BCTAL and the North Richland Hills Police Dept. Failure to abide by these rules may result in temporary or permanent loss of parking privileges. Parking Without a Valid Permit or not placing on the left side of the windshield <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ 1st offense = Warning sticker will be placed on the vehicle <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Students are required to immediately report to Mr. Williams office to make arrangements to secure proper permit and Parents Conference. ➤ 2nd offense = If a student has not secured a valid permit and has not made arrangements with Mr. Williams office, the security guard will be instructed to place a "Sticker Ticket" on the vehicle. ➤ 3rd offense = Parking privileges will be permanently suspended. Illegal or Inappropriate Parking *Students are to <u>ONLY</u> park in the South parking lot* Students are <u>NOT allowed</u> to park in the following spaces: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Handicapped Parking Spaces (unless visible and current hang tag is present, and registered in the student's name)
