Dismissal

Lunch

Following BISD's guidelines, parents will not be able to walk their child(ren) to class on the first day or at all for the foreseeable future.

- Doors will open at 7:40 am for all students. Students may eat breakfast in the cafeteria until there is no more room to do so. (Once the cafeteria is full, a student will walk to their classroom with their breakfast and eat it in there.)
- All other students (K-5) will walk straight to their classrooms and enter the rooms. Students will sit quietly at their assigned seat--they will be monitored and the classroom plan for what to do during this time will be established by the teacher.
- Older siblings may walk students in PK-1 to their classroom door before going to his/her own classroom.
- PK students will be met at the front doors and escorted to their classrooms and monitored by teachers/educational assistants.

The school day ends at 3:35pm. Masks will be worn during the dismissal process. Please refer to the dismissal map provided or link below to know where to pick up your child. Car tags are required for a staff member to dismiss your child to an individual.

Early Dismissal: Parents requesting early dismissal will enter the building with a mask and ID will be verified at the front office. We will call down to the classroom and request that the student be sent to the office for an early dismissal. If the child is a PK or Kindergarten student or needs assistance getting to the office a staff member will retrieve the student.

Rainv Dav Dismissal: K-4 will remain in their classrooms and a staff member will radio for a student's dismissal. Fifth grade will wait in the gym and listen for a student to be called before dismissing.

Following BISD's guidelines, parents will not be able to have lunch on campus with their child(ren) on the first day or at all for the foreseeable future.

Students will be spaced out at each table. Please let your child's teacher know if you need to fill out the Free and Reduced Meal program form, it can take up to a week to process the form. Returning students can pay by going to the following website: https://www2.mvpavmentsplus.co m/welcome

(vou will need the students' lunch account number). The lunch schedule and plan will be revisited each six weeks as family choice for face to face or online learning may change.

We have marked our cafeteria with paws on each table to ensure a student is seated 6 feet from their peers.

Parent Safety

Parents are required to wear a mask or a face covering during their visit on campus. We are asking to keep the number of visitors to a minimum. Please ring the bell outside and someone from the front office will greet you and get a few pieces of information. Once the door is opened please proceed to the office where we are happy to help you!

We are currently not allowing volunteers in the building for the protection of our students and staff.

Student Safety

All students will be required to wear masks at school.

There are close to 50 hand sanitizing stations around the school as well as hand sanitizer in each classroom. Teachers will be supplied with disinfecting wipes/cleaner to aid in the throughout-the-day cleaning. Additional cleaning and sterilization practices have been added into the daily schedule.

Each student will receive a colored foam mat to assist with flexible seating while social distancing.

Recess Grades Attendance

The playground equipment will be off-limits for the time being. Children will be allowed to play on the blacktop or field located by the playground. Students will be carefully monitored by their teachers.

Students will receive six daily grades and three major grades in each subject each six weeks. Their grades will be taken by their participation, demonstration of knowledge, and submitting of completed assignments.

School doors open at 7:40am. The school day starts at 8:00am. A student is tardy if he/she arrives after 8:10am. The school day ends at 3:35pm. Daily attendance will be taken, and compulsory attendance will be followed.
