## Dual Credit Grant Checklist

- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at [www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov).
- Confirm that your FAFSA has been sent to TCC.
- Check your **TCC** email to make sure that no additional FAFSA information or verification has been requested.
- Enroll in dual credit courses.
  - Students taking dual credit classes through their high schools will enroll in classes during their school's self-registration events each term.
  - Home school students must submit the Early High School Enrollment form to their campus dual credit office to enroll in classes, available at: [www.tccd.edu/academics/high-school-programs/dual-credit](http://www.tccd.edu/academics/high-school-programs/dual-credit).
